ICU Day

For more than 7 decades, Credit Unions around the world have united to celebrate the Credit Union Movement with the enormous difference that is made through it in the financial lives of our members. This celebration takes place each year on the third Thursday of October. This year, that day is Thursday, October 17, 2024. We invite our members to join in on the celebration of the Credit Union difference with the theme of "One World Through Cooperative Finance." This theme speaks to how Credit Unions still bring people together in cooperation to improve each other's financial well-being. "People Helping People" so members are able to save with a good return and borrow at a fair rate. In honor of this special day, Sentry Credit Union invites our members to stop by the branch for a sweet treat.

Right now millions of people worldwide choose Credit Unions for our "people first" philosophy, which drives us to constantly improve the financial lives of our members. What makes Credit Unions unique is our 7 cooperative principles that guide us in service. These principles are:

- 1. Voluntary and Open Membership all individuals who fall within a Credit Union's charter and who are willing to accept the responsibilities of membership are free to join a Credit Union.
- 2. Democratic Member Control One member, one vote. Each member, regardless of their financial status, has an equal say in the direction of their Credit Union. The Credit Union is governed by a volunteer board of directors elected by the members.
- 3. Member Economic Participation Members are both owners and customers of the Credit Union. They contribute to and democratically control the capital of the cooperative.
- 4. Autonomy and Independence The Credit Union is a self-reliant organization controlled by our member-owners, not outside stockholders.
- 5. Education, Training, and Information The Credit Union prioritizes financial education and training for our members.
- 6. Cooperation Among Cooperatives The Credit Union collaborates with other cooperatives at local, regional, national, and international levels to better serve all members and strengthen the movement.
- 7. Concern for Community While focusing on member needs, the Credit Union also works towards the development of our communities.

These principles, rooted in the philosophy of cooperation, guide our Credit Unions in the mission to help our members live their best financial lives.

recipe that his grandmother taught him to bake. From all of his practice, SCUBY is an excellent baker; he knew this recipe would sell out fast. He decided that he had to make Grandma SCUDAMORE'S scrumptious doggy treats. SCUBY enjoys this recipe so much that he wants to share it with you.

Grandma SCUDAMORE'S Scrumptious Doggy Treats

Makes 30 large bones

Ingredients

- 2 cups of whole-wheat flour
- 1 Tablespoon Baking Powder
- 1 cup natural peanut butter
- 1 cup skim milk

Instructions

- 1. Have an adult assist you.
- 2. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees.
- 3. In a bowl, combine flour and baking powder. In another bowl, mix peanut butter and milk.
- 4. Add wet ingredients to the dry ingredients and mix well.
- 5. Turn out the dough on a lightly floured surface and knead.
- 6. Roll out dough to ¼ inch thick and cut out shapes. SCUBY uses a bone shaped treat cutter, but you can use any shape you wish.
- 7. Place on a greased baking sheet and bake for 20 minutes or until lightly brown.
- 8. Cool on a rack.
- 9. Serve.
